And now you can too! You can start flight training at any age. To fly 'solo' (without an instructor) the minimum age is 16, and the minimum age to obtain a pilot certificate is 17.

More than a thousand hours of "pilot in command" time later, Gryphon still enjoys flying out of the Watsonville airport. There's a wonderful feeling of freedom and adventure that comes with being a pilot. Give it a try – it's a lot easier than you might think!
