TO OUR MEMBERS

Over the past several weeks we have been communicating with the Santa Cruz Board of Supervisors through our local supervisor, Zach Friend, to gain approval to safely reopen all, or at least portions, of the Club May 4. Zach has indicated the Board is willing to allow "members of the same household or living unit" to play tennis at the Club.

Currently, we plan to reopen our tennis courts to our Members who are "members of the same household or living unit" May 11. In addition, we will be opening Court 6 and Court 7 for ball machine usage to those Members who have paid for an annual pass (in 2019) or to Members who purchase an annual pass (for 2020)—one Member at a time. The tennis rebounder located next to Court 10 will also be made available—one Member at a time. Sanitation and social distancing protocols will be required and each Member who enters the Club will be asked to sign a waiver.

In addition to the actions summarized in our recent Member Updates, we have made the following improvements to your Club:

- Resurfaced the upper/lower Club House Deck and Railings
- Repaired the Fitness Center Staircase and Landing
- Purchased a new French Fryer and other equipment for the Kitchen
- Installed Plexiglass Barriers at the Front Desk
- Increased (substantially) our inventory of Hand Sanitizer and Anti-Bacterial Wipes
- Reconditioned the Clay Court and added 25 bags of clay
- Purchased a "touchless" Member Entry System

22 Staff Members have been working (at home and at the Club) during the past month and we plan to continue their employment this month. Several Staff Members are teaching daily online group exercise classes that can be live-streamed through the Club's Facebook Page while others are performing essential maintenance and administrative tasks.

This week we will be mailing our May statements. To those of you who contacted us last month, we appreciate your support for the Club; and we have responded to your requests. We thank everyone for their patience during this difficult time as we continue to improve the quality of your Club and maintain a substantial portion of our Staff in anticipation of reopening SOON!
