Three years ago, the then 19-year-old **Lithuanian**, **Laurynas Grigelis** was crowned the **Comerica Bank Challenger Champion**. This year, his shot at a second title was cut short as he lost today to **Great Brit's Richard Gabb** in the second round of the qualifying competition. This shows the strong caliber of player for this year's fierce main draw.

2014 NCAA Singles Champion, Marcos Giron from UCLA will compete tomorrow in his first round match as well as fellow Bruin teammate and 19-year-old Piedmont native, Mackenzie McDonald.

Marcos Baghdatis, former No. 8 in the world is set for the Tuesday feature match not before 5:45pm. Baghdatis just finished a strong week in Vancouver with a win over 2013 Seascape semifinalist, Farruk Dustov in the final. Injured free and healthy, the 2006 Australian Open finalist draws a competitive round for his Aptos debut.

One of **UCSC's** former stand out players, **Matt Seeberger**, will compete in the doubles action with the **No. 1** players from **UCLA**, **Clay Thompson** as his partner. The two will kick off their first match on Wednesday not before 2pm. Seeberger will have a bit of home court advantage playing in his familiar Santa Cruz terrain.
